

KDYT offer a range of services that we use to support young people, these include:

- 1 to 1 support on any issue important to them.
- Kidderminster Youth House - a safe place to come in times of need.
- The KDYT 'Triple A' Education Support Programme.
- Youth Worker based in the Big Lottery Funded Axis Youth Hub.
- Work Experience Placements.
- Accredited Training Programmes.
- Staff members trained in key areas including:
 - Mental Health First Aid
 - Protective Behaviours
 - CSE Prevention
 - Sexual Health
 - Drug & Alcohol Awareness
 - Restorative Justice

KDYT staff undertake continuous professional development to stay up to date with current theory and practice.

DAY TRIPS & RESIDENTIALS


KDYT activities are chosen by young people and are always good fun, creating memories for life. This year we have been to:

PROJECTS

2017/18 saw KDYT launch 3 new exciting projects:

'KDYT YOUTH CAFÉ' due to the fantastic support of The Big Lottery Fund, The Clothworkers Foundation and Safer Wyre Forest, the KDYT Youth Café is now being constructed. Young people have been fully involved in the design and layout of the café and have decided on opening hours.

'INCREASING RESPONSIBILITY PROMOTING OPPORTUNITY' funded by the West Mercia Police & Crime Commissioner this project engaged young people involved in, or at risk of being drawn into anti-social behaviour.

A structured programme supported them to develop resilience, understand the impact of ASB and to begin to make positive choices and help other young people by becoming KDYT Young Leaders.

'KDYT TRIPLE A EDUCATION SUPPORT PROGRAMME' following discussions with schools and young people, KDYT launched this project designed to work with young people who are struggling with their education.

Bringing together parents, schools and the young person a package of support is designed and delivered to support the young person and help address any barriers that might exist.

SUCCESS STORIES

MATT RECEIVES THE DIANA AWARD: We were delighted when Matt Thomas, a KDYT Young Leader received a Diana Award for over 4 years volunteering with KDYT. Matt's journey inspires other young people, especially those who are facing challenges and struggles in their lives.

WYRED FOR PRIDE 2018: KDYT's Flannel Club organised a fantastic event to celebrate LGBT+ History Month in February. Working with Wyre Forest District Council and with funding from Safer Wyre Forest an evening of music, poetry and comedy took place at Kidderminster Town Hall.

EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGISTS CONFERENCE: Young people from KDYT attended an Educational Psychologists Conference to speak about their experiences at school and to suggest how services can be improved, their input was described as 'phenomenal' and 'supremely helpful'.

ANTI-BULLYING WEEK 2017: KDYT ran a range of activities to raise awareness and took part in the This Morning Campaign to encourage people to #BEKIND, young people were excited when our project was mentioned on the ITV This Morning programme.

KDYT YOUNG LEADERS: Our young leaders have been amazing this year, they have helped us to run youth activities, supported various community events and have worked hard supporting other young people.

KIDDERMINSTER YOUTH HOUSE

Kidderminster Youth House has served the young people and community of Wyre Forest since it was built by KDYT in 1970 and it is used by more groups each year.

Facilities include a sportshall, performance spaces, boxing gym, multi-ball court, meeting rooms and the youth club area, which will soon become the KDYT Youth Café.

The building is used by a large number of agencies and it is estimated that over 750 individuals use the building each week.


